Enclosed in this packet is a crime victim compensation application. If you find you qualify and are interested in possibly obtaining compensation for eligible offenses, please take the time to fill this out and submit it to the State of Texas at the address provided. The Crime Victim Liaison will be in contact with you. If you have any questions please call or come to the Bellmead Police Department and the Crime Victim Liaison or an Investigator can assist you in filling out the application. In the near future you may be meeting with the McLennan County District Attorney's Office regarding the crime against you. Please take this packet with you and they may provide you with additional resources as well. Again you are not alone in this. If you need any further assisted please do not hesitate to contact me or the personnel at the Police Department.
